Psalm 33:6-9

Take a few minutes this morning to read these verses together outdoors in His creation.

God is good. He is the creator of everything. Let's read Psalm 33:6-9

By the word of the Lord the heavens were made,

their starry host by the breath of his mouth.

7 He gathers the waters of the sea into jars; He puts the deep into storehouses.

8 Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the people of the world revere him.

9 For he spoke, and it came to be; He commanded, and it stood firm.

This tells us God simply spoke and the heavens came into existence. David depicts God's breath creating everything which is seen in the heavens. This includes all the stars and planets. God is the creator of everything.

PSALM 139:14-17

What is God's greatest creation? Read Psalm 139:14-17

For you created my inmost being;

you knit me together in my mother's womb.

14 I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful,

I know that full well.

15 My frame was not hidden from you

when I was made in the secret place,

when I was woven together in the depths of the earth.

16 Your eyes saw my unformed body;

all the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.

17 How precious to me are your thoughts, God! How vast is the sum of them.
