Each group will receive black bulletin board paper and colored chalk to make a banner. Kids can express what they have learned.

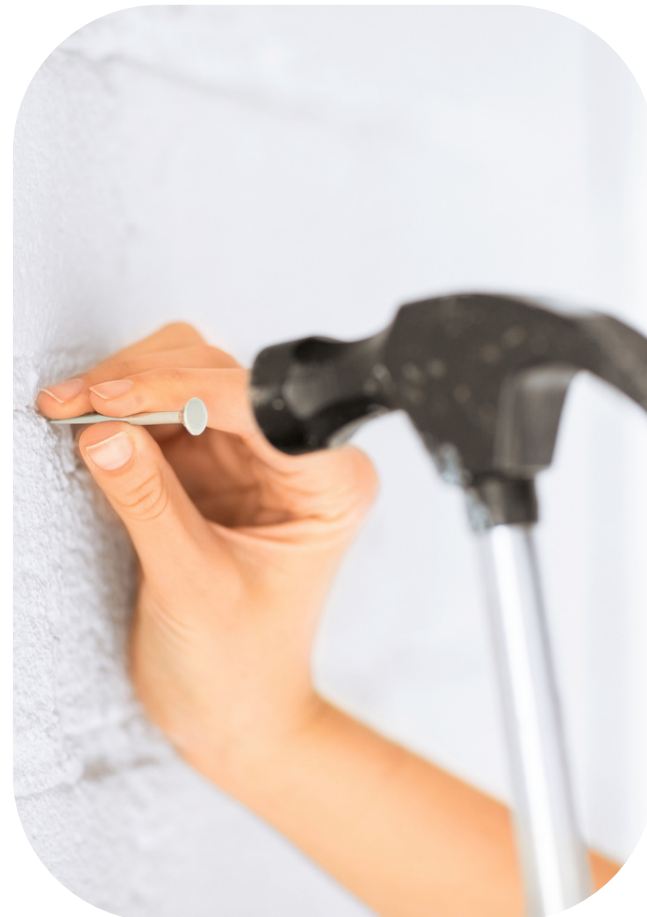
Hang the banner in the worship center by Wednesday morning.

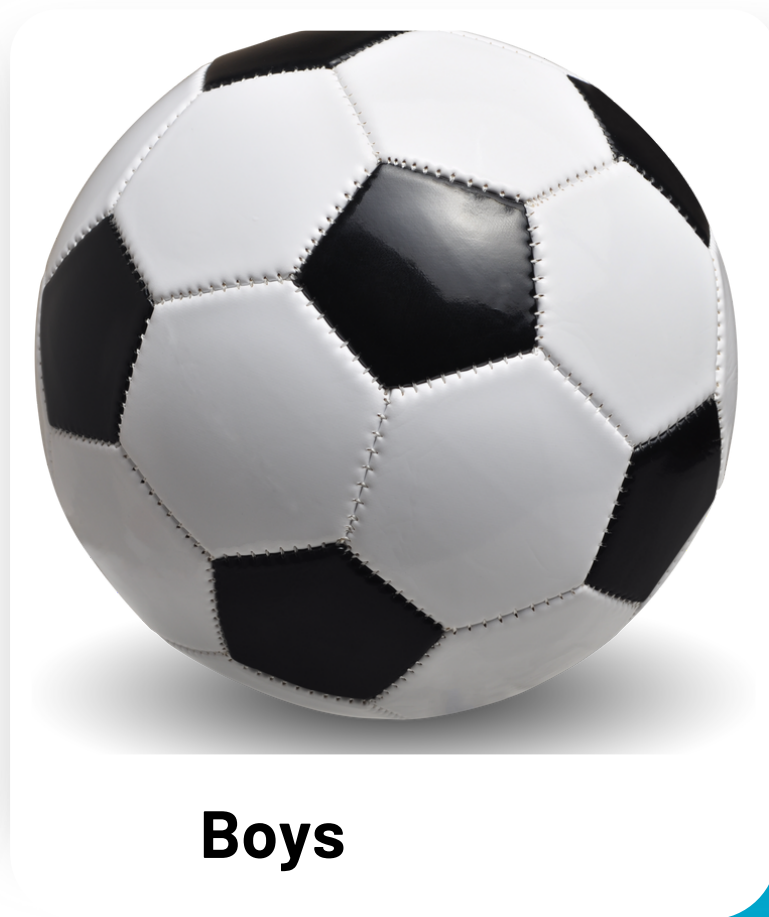

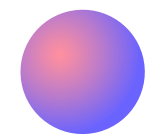
